Federal Contract to Process Thousands of Mainframe Tapes

*(Muller Media Conversions will be using its proprietary PC-based systems;
no mainframe equipment or resources needed)*

DENVER, CO—December, 2007 – The Minerals Management Service (MMS) of the U.S. Dept. of the Interior has awarded to Muller Media Conversions (MMC) a contract to process approximately 8,773 IBM 3490E cartridge tapes.

The work must be performed on site at the Denver Federal Center, Lakewood CO. The contractor will provide an inventory of original to copied tapes, a log of any problems reading or copying the originals, technical documentation of the equipment and software used, and the process used for copying. The contractor is providing all equipment, supplies, personnel, supervision and quality control to complete this project.

In addition, MMC will produce “virtual tape” files which will be available to the client as additional backup requiring far less shelf space, and capable of being reproduced on demand on other media types such as LTO, or even converted to PC compatible files—all without going back to the tapes.

One of MMC’s strengths over the years has been the fact that it is both a software development company and a conversion service bureau. “We eat our own cooking,” says president Chris Muller, “In the case of the MMS project, much of the software to be used is based on packages originally written by us for the National Archives and others—the same software we’ve been using and enhancing in our service bureau for years. Even when we’re developing completely new software, having a service bureau helps us see things from a user’s perspective.”

Not many conversion firms can claim to have covered “WWW”—*Nope, it’s not the web... in our case, it means Watergate, Whitewater and WorldCom!* Over the past 29 years, MMC staff have puzzled out and converted massive amounts of data involved with famous political situations, bankruptcies, tobacco litigation, etc. Conversions can be driven by the need for compliance, migration, litigation, etc. Whatever the need, MMC’s “*Raiders of the Lost Archives*” would be happy to help.
